RIDING LESSONS

Lessons are available at the beginner or intermediate levels on a private or group basis. Lessons are carefully supervised by experienced riders. Lessons are booked through the office in advance. Lessons are given both in the ring and on the trail as determined by the instructor. Parents are encouraged to attend at the stable when their children are being taught. It is expected that the Barn Rules be read and that all items be complied with. The Emergency Information and Waiver of Liability must be completed by the student or the student's parent or guardian if the student is under age.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

The Rider and his/her parents(s) and/or guardian(s) hereby agree to assume all responsibility and risk of bodily injury or damage to property, and further agree to hold harmless and indemnify Sandelwood, its Owners, Managers, Directors, Agents, Employees, and Riders from all claims for any bodily injury to persons or damage to property arising out of or resulting from the Rider's use of Sandelwood's premises, instruction, use and/or rental of horses at or from Sandelwood, or participation as a rider, groom, spectator or otherwise in horse shows or any type of riding event, clinic or any type of Sandelwood organized, sponsored, supported or endorsed activity, whether on Sandelwood premises or elsewhere and including transportation provided by Sandelwood or its Owners, Managers, Directors, Agents, Employees, and Riders.

The Rider and the undersigned parent(s) and/or guardian(s) do hereby consent to any X-ray examination, anaesthetic, medical or surgical diagnosis or treatment, and hospital services that may be rendered to the said Rider under general or specific instructions of any physician of the hospital. It is understood that this consent is given in advance of any specific diagnosis or treatment. The Rider and the undersigned parent(s) and/or guardian(s) agree to assume responsibility for payment of all fees for doctors, ambulances, and/or any other medical charges reasonably and necessarily incurred.

The Waiver of Liability includes all damages, loss or injury not know but which may arise in the future and all effects and consequences thereof.

- 2) All students must supply themselves with boots or shoes with a flat sole and low heel.
- 3) Riding helmets must be worn. If you do not own a helmet, an ASTA approved helmet may be borrowed from Sandelwood for your lesson.
- 4) Sandelwood reserves the right to re-schedule any student's lessons in order to accommodate any holidays or special events on site.
- 5) Sandelwood also reserves the right to terminate any student's lesson at its sole discretion. Any such cancellation will result in full refund of any lesson fees remaining at the time of termination.
- 6) A waiver of liability must be completed and signed at the time of registration.
